DoD Budget Plan Targets TRICARE

According to columnist Tom Philpot's recent <u>Military Up-date</u>, the DoD is proposing to merge the three options into a single fee-for-service insurance option, similar to the current standard option. The proposed changes to TRICARE military dependents and working-age military retirees would face higher out-of-pocket costs, which could include a share of medical expenses and perhaps a new annual enrollment fee, set initially at \$285 for individuals and \$569 for families.
