Compensation & Pension Exams

A C&P exam, a large piece of the evidence the VA uses when making a determination of your claim, is scheduled if the VA feels that they need more evidence to determine if your condition is service connected, if it needs to be diagnosed, or if it has become worse. If you fail to show up for your appointment without prior notice, the VA will use that as grounds to automatically deny your claim, no matter how strong
