Bernie Sanders, I-VT, that would "expand and enhance eligibility for health care and services through the Department of Veterans Affairs." Sanders bill would take into account the varying income levels among counties in any given state, and also establish new statewide income thresholds in determining veterans' eligibility for VA health care. The bill further stipulates that all required modifica- tions for modification of the new income criteria must be completed within five years of enactment. The IRS had been fining Legion posts up to \$1,000 per day for not keeping records of veterans' DD-214s or other valid documentation. The Legion felt it was being wrongly targeted, resulting in the passing of three resolutions dur- ing its 2013 National Convention in Houston last summer.
