Starting this spring, more than 400,000 military retirees and senior dependents in the TRICARE for Life Program will owe the full amount for certain prescription refills if they use a retail pharmacy rather than a military pharmacy or mail service. The change is part of a pilot program meant to help control the cost of military health care.
