### **ACA to Impact Some Federal Employees**

Starting in January under the Affordable Care Act, all individuals must maintain minimum health care coverage for themselves and all dependents claimed on their federal tax return, or must qualify for an exemption. Service members covered under the Federal Employees Health Benefits Program (including temporary continuation of coverage), Medicare, TRICARE and Children's Health Insurance Program meet the federal requirement. However, some civilian employees may not be covered, and should review their options in preparation for the 2013 Federal Benefits Open Season, Nov 11– Dec 9, 2013 when they can select qualifying health insurance. ### CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS AFFECT TEXAS VETS

The following proposed amendments to the Texas Constitution that will affect Texas veterans and/or their families:

Amendment No. 1 (HJR 62):

The constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to provide for an exemption from ad valorem taxation of all or part of the market value of the residence homestead of the surviving spouse of a member of the armed services of the United States who is killed in action.

Amendment No. 4 (HJR 24)

The constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to provide for an exemption from ad valorem taxation of part of the market value of the residence homestead of a partially disabled veteran or the surviving spouse of a partially disabled veteran if the residence homestead was donated to the disabled veteran by a charitable organization.
