## VOLUNTEERS NEEDED BY THE MEMORIAL SERVICES DETACHMENT FORT SAM HOUSTON NATIONAL CEMETERY

The purpose of this article is to make YOU aware of the Memorial Services Detachment (MSD) Honor Guard which was created in December 1991. All funds are from donations only which are solicited yearly from major corporations and government entities. Current membership is 96 recruits ranging from 72 to 88 years of age. Eligibility is a DD Form 214. Five squads - Weekly squads consists of 14-20 persons and each squad having a specific day. Average yearly expenditures for the MSD are \$12 to \$15 thousand dollars. What MSD would like as assistance: Help with recruiting, Funds, preferably recurring such as quarterly or yearly, get the word out on the MSD. This is a thankless service that MANY people are not aware of until needed. The Leaderships is continually looking for ways to better the MSD by recruiting, soliciting funds and sponsors, and awareness of the MSD. The Memorial Services Detachment (MSD) needs volunteers to serve as Honor Guard members. If you are a military veteran with an Honorable Discharge from any military service and have a free one-day a week, you may be able to volunteer and become a member. Uniforms are provided and prior honor guard experience is not necessary. Training will be provided. You may wear decorations listed on your DD214. We use the M1 Garand rifle to render the three-volleys of fire; we have several buglers who sound Taps, and we also use the electronic bugle when our buglers are not available.
