2015 Dues Cards Mandatory!!!

This time of year, members ask "Why do I have to show my membership card?" The answer is simple... "As of January 1st, your 2014 membership is expired".

Further, if you do not renew by February 1st, you will lose your continuous years of membership and be considered delinquent.

The American Legion membership year is July 1st to June 30th each year. This crosses 2 calendar years but it is the Fiscal Year for the National Legion. You hurt the post by waiting until December 31st to renew.

The National Commander Helms has announced a "member retention surge". He wants everybody to renew their membership and invite an eligible veteran. The American Legion is getting ready to celebrate 100 years and would like membership to be its largest ever for that celebration. With all the veteran's concerns it's important that Congress and other government agencies understand that the veterans do have a large and loud voice. Membership in The American Legion is a big part of that.

Boy's State

The American Legion has many programs that support the ideals of commitment to the advancement of Community, State, and Nation. As well as providing for the comfort and well-being of Veterans, The American Legion strives to aid in the growth and education of our youth. They are our future. One of the programs that specifically addresses the education of young men is American Legion Boy's State. You have probably heard about this program. In case you haven't, this is what it is about:

In the early 1930's there was a growth of socialism through Young Pioneer Camps throughout the United States. Two legionnaires from the state of Illinois decided that this was unacceptable and started the first American Legion Boy's State at the Illinois State Fair. The current program has grown immensely since then.

American Legion Boy's State is a program designed to educate young men about the true meaning of citizenship through the knowledge of how government works. High School Juniors that come from the top of their class are selected by counselors for eligibility to Boy's State. These fine young men are then screened by Post 593 and we select the top 6 – 8 to represent us as delegates in Austin. The program takes place the first week in June. Delegates travel to the University of Texas and participate for one week. They will learn the processes of government at all levels; City, County, and State. They will learn the methods of running for a multitude of offices ranging from City Councilman to State Governor. They will learn how to write, lobby for, and pass a Bill into law. They will attend a session of Congress at the State Capitol. These future leaders will make friendships and contacts that will stay with them forever. I attended Boy's State in the State of Montana many years ago and still remember the debate over the tax on milk. It isn't the significance of the topic; it is the experience that matters.

American Legion Boy's State has grown to become one of the most respected extracurricular programs in the United States. Many notable Americans have participated from all 55 Departments of The American Legion to include (in no particular order) Randy Beamer, Jon Bon Jovi, Michael Jordan, Bill Clinton, Robert Griffin III, Tom Brokaw, Neil Armstrong, Garth Brooks, and the current Governor of Wisconsin, Scott Walker. This is an outstanding program that Post 593 is proud to sponsor. So, when you hear this name in the near future as we begin our process of selecting the delegates for 2015, keep this information in mind. Ask any member of the Executive Committee if you have further questions. By all means, pull me aside and ask me anything you want in regards to Boy's State.

One last note; two boys from each Department Boy's State are selected to attend Boy's Nation in Washington, D.C. at a later date. There they will learn more about government at the national level.


Community Service 15 Can Challenge
