Commander's Corner

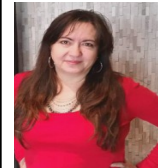

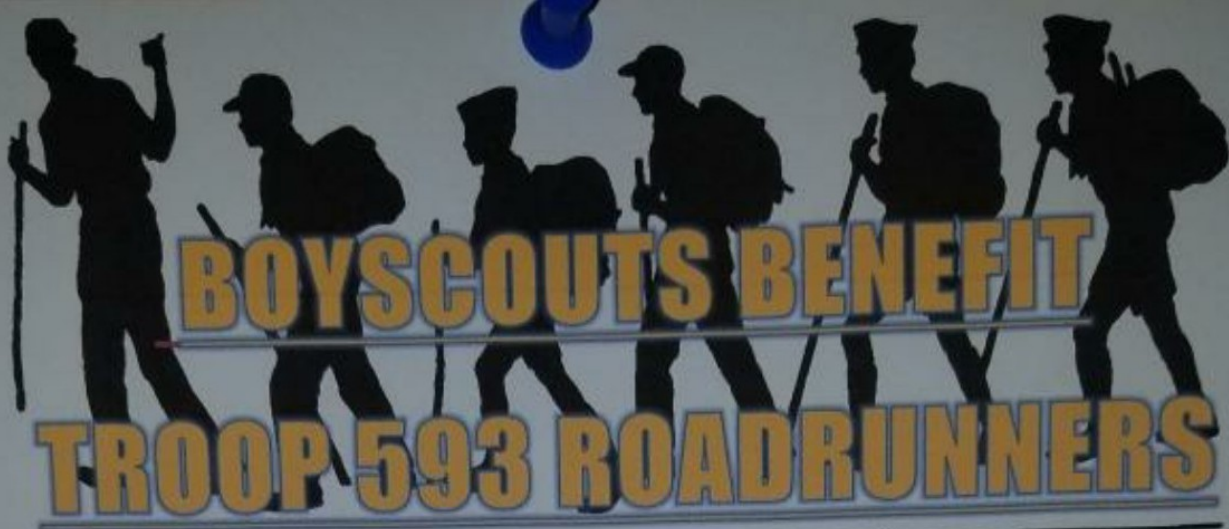

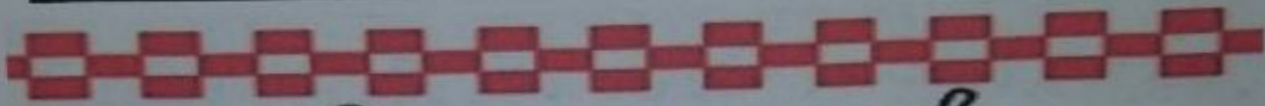
