Once again congratulations to Brad Martin for earning the State Award: **S. A. L. Dual Member of the Year !!**



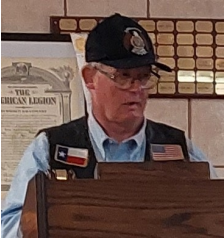

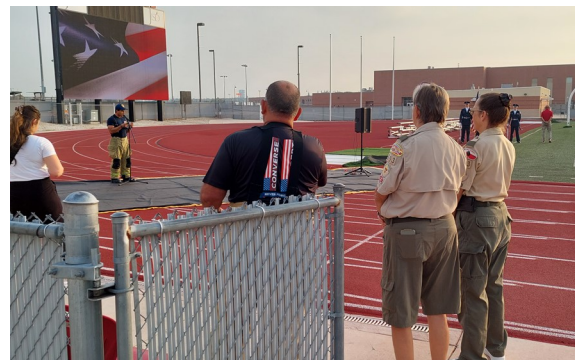
