
#### The Fourth Pillar-

September Court of Honor (Awards Ceremony) saw Troop 593 Scouts receive nearly 75 Awards ranging from Marksmanship Awards for Rifle, Shotgun, and Archery to Merit Bandages in the areas of possible careers, hobbies, and Life Lessons to Rank Advancement.

This month the troop went to McKinney Falls State Park for their campout. They learned about fishing, bird study, and cooking. Additionally with September being Suicide Awareness Month we opened up a dialog about the need to reach out when you are depressed and how to get help to those who may need assistance. They found out that suicide is the second leading cause of death for 10 to 24 year olds.

Post 593 gives these youth great life lessons, thank you so much!!





#### **WARNING SIGNS OF SUICIDE:**

The behaviors listed below may be some of the signs that someone is thinking about suicide.

#### **TALKING ABOUT:**



- ▶ Wanting to die
- ▶ Great guilt or shame
- Being a burden to others

#### **FEELING:**



- ▷ Empty, hopeless, trapped, or having no reason to live
- Extremely sad, more anxious, agitated, or full of rage
- ightharpoonup Unbearable emotional or physical pain

#### **CHANGING BEHAVIOR, SUCH AS:**



- Making a plan or researching ways to die
- Withdrawing from friends, saying goodbye, giving away important items, or making a will
- ▶ Taking dangerous risks such as driving extremely fast
- Displaying extreme mood swings
- □ Using drugs or alcohol more often

If these warning signs apply to you or someone you know, get help as soon as possible, particularly if the behavior is new or has increased recently.


Excerpt from our National Commander James LaCoursiere, Jr.'s article (American Legion, Sep 18, 2024)
